



CALENDAR FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2010/2011

- Staff seminar: 11 and 12 August.
- Postponed/re-sit examination: Week 32 (and possibly week 31).
- For all new students, the opening of the academic year 2010/2011 is Wednesday 18 August at 10.00. There will be student based sessions with registration and orientation during the day. Buddy programmes for buddies and the first year students will also be arranged.
- For all other students, the academic year 2010/2011 starts Monday 16 August, if no other agreements have been made.
- Quality seminar: 15 and 16 October.
- Open day: Wednesday 3 November.
- Autumn semester ends: Tuesday 21 December.
- Spring semester starts Monday 3 January, except for students at Faculty of Computer Science and Media Technology (CMT) and Faculty of Technology, Economy and Management (TEM), who have their first ordinary day of teaching Monday 10 January. See time schedule for information about classroom and lecture times. There will be postponed/re-sit examination for students at CMT and TEM January 3 - January 9. At Faculty of Health, Care and Nursing, the postponed/re-sit examination will be notified in a separate exam plan, spread throughout the academic year.
- Easter (no lectures): 18 April – 25 April.
- The academic year ends: Friday 17 June.
- Some study programmes do not follow all the sections in the calendar. There are other starting dates for the Technical Summer School students, pre-course students and for some of the master and further educational programmes. The study programme coordinator is responsible for giving the necessary information to the students involved.
